Entries may be submitted by all persons holding a valid FIA Competition Licence, and meeting the requirements as stated below, but will be valid for acceptance only if made on the Official Entry Form, properly completed, signed by the entrant, driver and navigator, and accompanied by the appropriate entry fee. The number of main field starters is limited to 151. A further 30 applicants will be placed on a reserve list. The Junior Rally will cover the final 4 stages on the final day of the rally, the maximum number of junior starters permitted is 40. The event will consist of approximately 300 road kms and 230 stage km.
