



Competing Championship 2008

- The 2008 championship will consist of three categories - Senior, Junior and Ladies.
- You must be a paid up member of the club at the time of registering.
- The championship will consist of 13 rounds:
 1. Autotest - Sunday 17th February
 2. Hillclimb - Saturday 29th March
 3. Hillclimb - Sunday 30th March
 4. Bowling - April date to be confirmed
 5. Karting - May date to be confirmed
 6. Forestry - Sunday 8th June
 7. Sprint - Saturday 12th July
 8. Sprint - Sunday 13th July
 9. Fun Night in conjunction with rally launch, August date to be confirmed
 10. Rally - Saturday 6th September
 11. Rally - Sunday 7th September
 12. Autotest - Sunday 5th October
 13. Quiz Night - November date to be confirmed (Team event)
- Points will be awarded based on your finishing class position on events relevant to other registered competitors in that class.
- Points will be awarded as follows:
 - > Points for rounds 1-6, 8, 9, 12 & 13 will be based on 20, 18, 16, 15, 14, 13, down to 1 point.
 - > Points for round 7 will be based on 30, 27, 24, 23, 22, down to 1 point.
 - > Points for rounds 10 & 11 will be based on 10, 9, 8, down to 1 point.
 - > Bonus points scheme for round 9 will be announced at a later date.
 - > Points will be awarded on a category basis and an overall basis.
 - > 1 point will be awarded for an event that you start but are not classified as a finisher on.
 - > Points will not be back dated from events completed before registration.
- Best 9 rounds to count, at least 2 of which must be either round 4, 5, 9 or 13. At least 3 of which must be rounds 1-3, 6-8, and 10-12.
- Minimum of 6 rounds must be contested to qualify for an award.
- 5 bonus points (a maximum of 10) can be gained for marshalling at a neighbouring clubs event on our behalf. The onus is on the competitor to show their club membership card signed by the chief marshall of the event where they marshalled to a club championship organiser.
- Juniors are not eligible to compete on round 10 but may compete in junior classes on round 11..
- On round 13, teams will be made up of four people. In the event of more than one registered competitor on a team, points will be split equally between the registered competitors or one member of the team can be nominated to receive the points.
- Competitors may nominate a round of their choice for which they may receive double points. This must be stated at the time of registration and cannot be changed. Round 7 cannot be nominated for double points.
- All queries should be directed to the championship organisers. Should they fail to resolve a query, it will be referred the serving club chairman, secretary and treasurer at the time of the dispute. Their decision will be final.
- Organisers reserve the right to alter rounds of the championship and add awards in the case of unforeseen circumstances. All championship competitors to be contacted in the event of any changes.
- Juniors must be no more than 27 years of age on the 1st of January 2008.
- Awards are as follows, prizes will be decided at a later date
 - > 1st, 2nd and 3rd Overall
 - > 1st, 2nd and 3rd Junior
 - > 1st, 2nd and 3rd Lady
- Competitors may only receive one award. On publication of final results, if you are eligible for more than one award you will be contacted by the organisers and asked to declare which one you wish to receive.
- An entry fee will apply to all rounds except round 9.
