The Competition will be held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the General Competition Rules of MI and these Supplementary Regulations including Appendix '2', '25' and '32' of the current Motorsport Ireland Yearbook and Motorsport Ireland Motorsport Bulletins where appropriate, as issued during 2008, and any final instructions issued by the promotors. All competitors who forward an entry form agree to be bound by these rules. Copies of the Motorsport Ireland 2008 Yearbook and Motorsport Bulletins, are available from Motorsport Ireland, 34 Dawson St., Dublin 2. Phone: 01 6775628 or to download on www.motorsportireland.com Entries may be submitted by all persons holding a valid FIA Competition Licence, and meeting the requirements as stated below, but will be valid for acceptance only if made online at www.wexfordmotorclub.com or on the Official Entry Form, properly completed, signed by the entrant, driver and navigator, and accompanied by the appropriate entry fee.

Entry fee includes standard rate I.R.D.S. Insurance (MSA licence holders competing in MI permitted events must produce either a Letter of Acceptance from NES which has not yet expired, or one of the recently introduced BRDS Letters, application forms available at www.motorsportireland.com) to aid in speeding up document scrutiny and avoid the organisers having to handle large sums of money on the day, but is not a guarantee of insurance cover being available until a valid letter of acceptance is produced and verified), and Competitor Personal Accident Insurance for driver and navigator. - (2) Motorsport Ireland National B Licence Holders who may only drive cars up to 1650cc
- (3) Co-Drivers must hold Driver or Navigational Licence
- (4) MSA Licence holders of a grade not lower than National B Stage Rally

The final list of starters for the event will be drawn up from the entries received by means of a ballot by the Committee of Wexford Motor Club. Entry Fees, less a deduction of 50 euro, will be refunded to entrants/drivers who withdraw their entry, in writing, before, Monday 2nd June. Entries withdrawn after this date will only be refunded, less a deduction of 50 euro, provided the organisers start a reserve to fill this place.

CLASSES

- Class 1 Cars up to 1450cc*
- Class 2 Cars from 1451cc to 1650cc with only two valves per cylinder*
- Class 3 Cars from 1451cc to 1650cc with more than two valves per cylinder*
- Class 4 Cars from 1651cc to 2050cc with only two valves per cylinder*
- **Class 5** Cars 2051cc to 3500cc including all two wheel drive cars with more than two valves per cyclinder over 1651cc, V8's normally aspirated*
- Class 6 4WD. Four wheel drive excluding all WRC cars. Cars in this class must comply with their last published homologation papers, FI.A. Appendix J. Including: - Metro 6R4's are per Group B. 2777 homologation papers and the following; Maximum 2800cc, with 65mm plenum restrictor or 2500cc with trumpeted induction and must run with MSA certified engine only. The engine certificate must be presented to each event scrutineer.

Subaru Legacy Homologation Nos. A5399 and N5399 may be fitted with a Turbo charger fitted normally to Subaru Impreza and complying with Homologation No. A5480 or N5480
 Ford Escort RS Cosworth, Homologation No. A5466 and Ford Sierra Cosworth 4x4 homologation number A5414 may run with non-homologated gearbox. No other modifications are permitted and the car must comply with the homologation papers
 Additional cars authorised at the discretion of Motorsport Ireland in advance may also be allowed to enter this class but must not exceed 3500cc.

- **Class 7** All WRC cars only. Cars must comply with their last published Group A homologation papers as per F.I.A. Appendix J.
- Class 8 Group N Four wheel drive cars complying with their last published homologation papers as per F.I.A. Appendix J
- **Class 9** Junior Class: This class is open to drivers born on or after 1st January 1982, driving cars up to 1650cc, 2 wheel drive, normally aspirated (including competitors and cars eligibly for classes A H of the MI National Junior Rally Championship see Appendix 16).
