# **Wexford Motor Club Championship Regulations 2016**

### **Format Championship**

The championship will be <u>one</u> league table for all members

### Eligibility

The championship will be confined to members of Wexford Motor Club that are over 18 and fully paid up members prior to the event on which they wish to score points.

## The Scoring Events are in 3 Sections:

Competing members (Drivers/Navigators) <u>must</u> include one counting round from Section 1 or Section 2 as a Marshal

Maximum 3 counting scores taken from each section

The 3 sections are as follows:

### Section 1 - Wexford club events - 3 of 6 events to count [for Competitors]

# How to score points

#### **Section 1 Wexford events:**

For Drivers or navigators	Non competing members / Event Administrators
Class win = 15 points	Marshall / Administrator for event = 7 points
2nd in class = 13 points	
3rd in class = 11 points	Additional Bonus points awarded at COC's discretion
4th in class = 10 points	1 Award of 4 points
5th in class = 9 points	2 Awards of 3 points
6th in class = 8 points	3 Awards of 2 points
Finishing event =7 points	4 Awards of 1 point

### **Section 2 Neighbour events:**

For Drivers or navigators	Non competing members / Event Administrators
Class win = 15 points	
2nd in class = 13 points	Marshall / Administrators for event = 7 points
3rd in class = 11 points	
4th in class = 10 points	
5th in class = 9 points	
6th in class = 8 points	
Finishing event =7 points	

### **Section 3 Social events:**

Winner on day = 15points	
2nd on day =13 points	
3rd on day = 12 points	
4th on day = 11 points	
5th on day = 10 points	
6th on day = 9 points	
7th on day = 8 points	
8th on day = 7 points	
Finish event = 5 points

## THE RULES

Substitution of events or alternation of dates will be at the discretion of the club, who reserve the right to cancel a round, accept a change of date, substitute a nominated event, or alter the number of events on which scores will count.

Competitors are registered for the championship when they start an event provided that their membership is fully paid up and have signed off on championship register form

The onus is on the competitor to provide evidence to the Championship Registrar that they have completed the days of marshalling (re: sign on) competitor (re- final results sheet)

For section 1 & 2: The points will be awarded as per overall class results on the final official results sheet for the event

For section 1 & 2: Non competing member's points will be awarded as per marshal sign on sheet provided by the club running event or administrators listing from COC of event. (Please write your name and WMCC clearly on sign on sheets)

MI appointed officials cannot score points at an event they attend to officiate at. This also applies to any MI Officials driver.

#### **More Small Print**

Ties will be resolved in favour of the competitor with the greatest number of wins, and failing this the greatest number of second places etc. until the tie is resolved. If further ties remain they will ultimately be decided on the basis of performance in the sequential order of events in the championship, starting at the first event.

In case of any doubt the interpretation of these rules shall rest with the registrar of the championship in consultation where necessary with the committee of Wexford Motor Club.
