Amendments to these supplementary Regulations will be issued by numbered bulletins. All competitors who submit entry forms agree to be bound by these regulations.

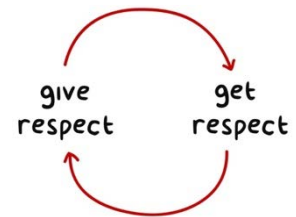

4.0 ENTRIES

4.1 Information:

4.1.1 Entries may be submitted by all persons holding a valid FIA Competition License or Commercial Entrants License as issued by a recognized ASN.

4.1.2 All entries must be made on the Official Entry Form available through.

<https://www.shannonsportsit.ie/evo/Login?event=IE-WXFD-WX26>

The entrants name or entry ID (OL/xxxxx) to be used as a reference when paying for entry. (Online entries will only be accepted).

All entry forms must be fully completed and signed by the entrant/driver and navigator, accompanied by the appropriate fee, and forwarded to the Entries Secretary. Incomplete or illegible forms will be returned.

4.1.3 Entries from other (non-MI/MSUK) ASN license holders from abroad may be accepted provided: STAGE RALLY license holders from abroad may be accepted provided:

- **4.1.3.1:** The license holder has written permission from his/her ASN (National Governing Body) to compete in the declared "national competition organised abroad".
- **4.1.3.2:** The license holder holds an STAGE RALLY license of appropriate grade.
- **4.1.3.3:** The Motorsport Ireland (MI) office has been contacted in the first instance and has given PRIOR approval for each individual competitor before an entry can be accepted. Written proof of which must be provided to the organisers.

The number of starters in the main field will be limited to: 150.

If more than 150 entry applications are received the organisers will nominate reserve entries. Such reserves may replace withdrawn entries up to a maximum of 150 starters. Reserve entries will be taken in numerical order for this purpose. No more than 25 Junior cars will start at the beginning of Leg 2.

Note: The license holder must be listed on the IRDS/ BRDS Database published weekly on MI Website. BRDS can be applied for via the MI website or by contacting the MI office. This must be applied for a minimum of 2 weeks before the event.

4.2 Entry Fee:

The Main Field entry fee is €1,390.00. (€25.00 Credit Card Charge)

The Historic (Class 17-19) entry fee is €1,390.00. (€25.00 Credit Card Charge)

The Junior (Class 16) entry fee is € 795.00 (€25.00 Credit Card Charge)

The entry fee includes the Personal Accident Insurance, IRDS / BRDS Insurance at standard rate.

Prior to the event, all competitors should ensure they are listed on the IRDS / BRDS Data Base, as published weekly by Motorsport Ireland. **NO IRDS/BRDS, NO START.**

IMPORTANT – Ensure competitor name is included as the reference of withdrawal. Withdrawal of all entries must be completed via email to the Event Secretary.

Withdrawals: Entries withdrawn by 5pm on Sunday the 30st of August 2026 will receive a full refund. Entries withdrawn between the 1st & the 10th of September 2026 will have a €150 administration fee. If you withdraw after Thursday 10th at 10am you will lose 50% of the entry fee.

Refunds will be issued within two weeks following the rally.

Please note: Withdrawal of all entries must be completed via email or WhatsApp to the Event Secretary.

IMPORTANT – Please remember to include your on-line entry reference (OL/XXXXX) number when making payments. If at least one reference number is not used while filling in and paying for your entry it will be classed as an incomplete entry and will be placed on the reserve list.

4.3 Entry Criteria:

In the event of an excess of 150 main field entries being received the following criteria will be applied to all entries received from the opening to the closing date of entries.

1. Entries that have been paid in full.
2. Previous Winners of the Event.
3. Registered Competitors of the Suirway Group South East Stages Championship, Hugo Loonam Midlands East Rally Championship & The Stellantis Rally Cup Ireland.
4. Working Members of Wexford Motor Club (Members who have volunteered at a Wexford Motorclub event in 2026).
5. Up to 30 entries at the Organisers Discretion.

Only fully paid up entries on the closing date will get priority entry as per championship requirements. (Providing they comply with the Event Entry Criteria)

5.0 CLASSES

5.1 Included Classes:

The event will include classes, as per Appendix 29.1 of the current Motorsport Ireland Yearbook.

5.2 Notes on Classes:

For further details on requirements for cars in classes 1 to 7, refer to www.fia.com, Appendix J, articles 252 to 261. (Article 260 refers to cars in Group R)

Refer to Appendix 29.1, Notes on Classes, Articles 1 to 24 of the current Motorsport Ireland Yearbook for further information on class eligibility.

Historic cars in classes 17, 18 & 19 must have an HRVIF or HTP (as appropriate) which must be produced at scrutineering. Cars without a valid HRVIF or HTP will not be permitted to start the event.

6.0 RECONNAISSANCE

6.1 Information:

Pace notes will be allowed on the event and competitors will be allowed to make pace notes 2 days, which are the 10th & 11th September 2026 from 09:00 to 17:00.

Competitors must sign on before commencing reconnaissance at:

Time & Date: 10th & 11th of September 2026 from 08:00 to 11:00.

Recce stickers must be displayed on the reconnaissance car windscreen.

6.2 Pace note providers:

Pace notes will be available for sale by third parties. The club has no involvement in their preparation and accepts no responsibility or liability for their accuracy or otherwise.

6.3 Restrictions:

Your attention is also drawn to Appendix 29, Article 4 of the current Motorsport Ireland Yearbook referring to a competitor found on a stage outside the reconnaissance period.

6.4 Penalties:

As per the current Motorsport Ireland Yearbook.

7.0 ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

- Documentation scrutineering is located at Rally HQ, Whites Hotel (Y35 C5PF) on Friday 11th September 2026 from 14:30 to 19:30.
- Competition licenses and other documentation as requested must be presented at documentation scrutineering.
- **IMPORTANT – COMPETITORS UNDER 18**
- Competitors under 18 years of age (Minor) must be entered in the event by the holder of a Minor Entrant Licence who must countersign the entry form. A Minor Entrant who is not the parent/legal guardian of the Minor, must be Garda Vetted. Where an adult sits in the same car as a Minor competitor, the adult must be the holder of a Minor Entrant Licence, if they are not the Minor's Parent/Legal Guardian this licence must include Garda Vetting. It is not permitted to have two minors in the same vehicle.

8.0 SCRUTINEERING

- Mechanical Scrutiny will take place on: 11th September 2026 from 14:00 to 19:00 on the Quay, Wexford.
- Post Event Eligibility Checks will take place by invitation at: Slaney View Motors, Wexford.
- Refer to Appendices 2 and 29.1 of the current Motorsport Ireland Yearbook for scrutiny requirements.
- Safety Tracking system is mandatory on Motorsport Ireland Stage Rally events. Installation of this needs to be carried out before mechanical scrutineering. The installation of the tracking system will be checked at scrutineering.
The Rally Tracking System equipment will be distributed prior to scrutineering. Installation of this equipment must be completed before mechanical scrutineering. It is essential that the system is installed in the car prior to scrutineering, and the fitting will be inspected during this process

The use of a 4Rally power cable supplying 12V is mandatory for all cars. Information regarding the supplier(s) of this cable will be provided in an upcoming Numbered Bulletin.

9.0 SERVICING

- There will be a designated fixed Service Area.
** Saturday & Sunday - Wexford Racecourse, Newtown Road, Wexford **
- Outside of the Service Area, Support / Service is expressly forbidden. (Article 11.5, Appendix 29 of the current Motorsport Ireland yearbook.
- Judges of Fact will monitor the route.
- Ground sheets must be utilized by all crews.
- Waste /Recycling bins will be provided in the Service Area and all crews are requested to place all rubbish and recyclable items in the bins.
- Competitors are requested to remove all oil / fluids and tyres from the Service Area.
- Please refer to Appendix 25, Art. 2.10.2 of the current Motorsport Ireland Yearbook regarding fire extinguishers requirements and signage in the Service Area.
- Smoking by competitors or service crews is prohibited within the Service Area.

9.1 REFUELING

9.1 Fuel is not permitted to be stored in, or dispensed from, the Service Park. All competitors must refuel in the designated Refuel Area, or by written prior permission from the organisers, from commercial filling stations indicated in the event road book. More Information may follow in Final Instructions or In Bulletins.

9.2 Crews using their own refuelling systems must use the designated Refuel Area.

9.3 – Penalties – As per the current MI Regulations.

9.4 Failure to comply with these refuelling regulations will be reported to the COC and penalties may apply.

9.5 Each crew is responsible for the actions of their service crew and any breach of these regulations.

9.6 No access is permitted to the Refuel Area, with the exception of the competitors availing of the refuel rig (if available) or competitors self-refuelling and nominated personnel. All competitors must exit the car while refuelling is in operation and they must follow the instructions of the refuelling operators and marshals.

9.7 Refueling is only allowed in Refuelling Area and designated commercial fuel stations.

10.0 FEATURES OF THE RALLY

10.1 Competitors Safety Briefing:

Competitors will be requested to log onto the Sportivity channel for the event and click on the link to watch the competitor safety briefing online. This video must be viewed by both Driver and Co-driver prior to documentation scrutiny. At documentation scrutiny, when completing the event declaration, crews will be asked to tick a box confirming that both crew members have watched the video in full.

10.2 Route Information:

The rally will take place over a route of approximately: **203 Stage** kilometres and **341 Road** kilometres, comprising of sealed surface stages with service after Parc Ferme Out, SS3 & SS6 on Saturday and after Parc Ferme, SS12 & SS15 on Sunday.

Cars in the Junior Class (Class 16) will compete over 9 stages, SS10 to SS18.

Cars in the Historic Classes (17, 18 and 19) will compete over all stages.

10.3 Super Rally:

A restart after retirement facility, as per Art 13, Appendix 29 of the current Motorsport Ireland Yearbook, will be operated on the rally.

11.0 SUPER RALLY (RESTART AFTER RETIREMENT)

11.1 General

11.1.1: The rally will operate Super Rally in accordance with Art 13, Appendix 29 of the current Motorsport Ireland Yearbook.

11.1.2 (Leg 1) A crew retiring from the rally between Parc Ferme Out and Arrival Control of SS3, may restart the rally from Service Out Control after 3 stages, Service Out Control after 6 stages or from Overnight Parc Ferme (subject to compliance with 11.3.1 below).

A Crew retiring from the rally on Special Stages 3, 4, 5 and up to the Arrival Control on SS6, may restart from Service Out Control after 6 stages or from Overnight Parc Ferme (subject to compliance with 11.3.1 below).

A Crew retiring on Special Stages 6, 7, 8 or 9 may only restart from the Overnight Parc Ferme (subject to compliance with 11.3.1 below).

If a crew are unable to re-start at Service Out Control after 3 or 6 stages, they must have their car in Parc Ferme not later than 22.30 hours on Saturday night. They may then restart, subject to passing scrutiny, on Leg 2 at Overnight Parc Ferme Out Control if they are to continue to be classified in overall results.

11.1.3 (Leg 2) A crew retiring from the rally between the Overnight Parc Ferme Out and Arrival Control of SS12, may restart the rally from Service Out Control after 12 stages, or Service Out Control after 15 stages (subject to compliance with 11.3.1 below).

A Crew retiring from the rally on Special Stages 12, 13, 14 and up to the Arrival Control of SS15, may only restart from Service Out Control after 15 stages (subject to compliance with 11.3.1 below).

No restart will be permitted for crews retiring on Special Stages 15, 16, 17 or 18.

A restart will not be permitted where a crew has been excluded for non-compliance with eligibility requirements, traffic violations or a decision of the COC / SRC. (Super Rally Coordinator).

On retirement the crew must hand in their timecards to Car Accountability or the marshal / timekeeper at the next available location / Time Control.

Crews must retain the duplicate copy of the timecard, to present to SRC as proof of stages completed.

11.1.4 Competitors must register for Super Rally if they wish to restart by contacting the SRC prior to a time that will be specified in Final Instructions or a bulletin.

Service Vehicles will not be permitted to access the Stage or any closed road between runs. The organisers will, where possible, endeavour to remove any car to the nearest location where it can be removed from the stage.

The transport of the car from that location is the responsibility of the competitor. The car must return by direct route to the Service Area.

11.1.5 Competitors availing of Super Rally must present themselves at the appropriate Service Out Control with their car, for re-scrutineering.

Due time is 10 minutes before their original due time at that Control, and 15 Minutes maximum lateness will apply.

11.1.6 The SRC, once satisfied that the crew meets the conditions for a restart, will issue new timecards which will have a restart time and restart Control Number.

The restart position within the field shall be at the discretion of the COC / SRC.

11.1.7 The organisers reserve the right to disallow restart on safety grounds or if the restart would interfere with the running of the rally.

11.2 Penalties:

11.2.1 Penalties will be applied as per the current Motorsport Ireland Yearbook.

11.3 Award Eligibility:

11.3.1 In order to be classified as a finisher the crew must complete 50% of the stages, which must include the final loop of stages and the finish control.

11.3.2 Crews completing the rally under Super Rally regulations will be eligible to score points in Championships.

14.0 PROVISIONING

Regarding Postponement, Abandonment or Cancellation of the event.

The organizers reserve the right to postpone, cancel or abandon the event in circumstances such as:

- Insufficient entries received at the closing date for entries.
- On safety grounds.
- Force Majeure.

14.1 If a decision to postpone, cancel or abandon the event is made, the organisers will communicate this decision using one of or a combination of the following:

- Final instruction posted on club website: www.wexfordmotorclub.ie
- Final instruction posted on Sportity App.
- Final instruction posted or emailed directly to the crew member nominated as official contact on entry form.
- Direct instruction to at least one of the crew from an official of the event.

Every effort will be made by the organisers to communicate such a decision in a timely manner however, in circumstances of force majeure or on safety grounds, it may be necessary to make such a decision during the running of an event. In such cases, this decision will be communicated via direct instruction from an official of the event.

In the event of cancellation or postponement for more than 24 hours, entry fee shall be refunded in accordance with GCR 51.2.
